# Cat and dog registration encourages responsible ownership.

Your cat or dog registration tag is its life insurance and must be worn at all times

**You can register your cat or dog for one or three registration periods.  
The registration period is from 1 September to 31 August**

## Fees

Council offers the option of a one or three year registration. If your pet is currently registered for three registration periods, you will be issued with an annual registration notice (no payment required). The annual registration period is from 1 September to 31 August.

## Pensioners

Recipients of a **pensioner concession card** or a **repatriation health card for all conditions** (as described in Council's Remission of Rate Policy) are eligible for a concession of half the prescribed fee. This concession applies to the first two cats and the first two dogs registered. Proof of pension entitlement is required.

## Replacement tags

Should your cat or dog lose its registration tag, you can purchase a replacement tag from any Council Customer Service Centre.
