



Graduates, apprentices, trainees

The Gold Coast City Council is working hard to build a vibrant city, maintain our enviable Gold Coast lifestyle and ensure our city will be thriving, sustainable and attractive into the future.

As an employer, Council recognises the importance of attracting and nurturing people through graduate, apprenticeship and traineeship pathways.

Graduates

Our graduates are employed in a number of job families, such as engineers, planners and librarians. They may enter a “graduate progression” scheme which supports and develops their skills and experience over a defined time period.

Apprentices

Council offers apprenticeship opportunities from time to time. These opportunities can cover a number of trades such as building, mechanical engineering, and fitting and turning.

Trainees

Commencing in January each year, Council advertises a host of 12-month traineeship opportunities ranging from:

- Certificate III in Business [Office Administration]
- Certificate III Library and Information Services
- Certificate II in Horticulture [Parks & Gardens]
- Certificate II in Conservation and Land Management (Natural Area Restoration)
- Certificate II in Water Operations

School-based traineeships are also offered which are typically recruited early in Year 11 and conclude during year 12. The school Vocational Education teacher is a good source of further information for these schemes.
