Environmental health

Our officers conduct routine assessments and investigate complaints relating to areas such as food safety, pollution, swimming pools, rental accommodation, and public areas.

Animal control

Our animal control team carry out regulatory tasks relating to animal management and control, and help the community by providing animal ownership education and support.

Parking

Our parking officers enforce the city's regulated parking and associated local laws by undertaking routine patrols to ensure necessary compliance within the community.
