



Windaroo-Bannockburn Statistical Profile

Introduction

This information is for Windaroo-Bannockburn Statistical Local Area (SLA) in Gold Coast City. Unless otherwise stated, all data are from the Time Series Profile of the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) 2001 Census of Population and Housing (taken on 7 August 2001), which counts both residents and domestic visitors to the SLA on Census night.

Resident Population

The preliminary estimate of the resident population of Windaroo-Bannockburn at 30 June 2002 was 2,727 people, an increase of 247 or 10.0% since 1997.

Age

In 2001, the number of people aged under 15 years represented 26.4% of the population of Windaroo-Bannockburn (down from 26.9% in 1991), higher than for Gold Coast City (19.3%). People aged 65 years and over represented 7.7% (up from 6.1% in 1991), lower than for Gold Coast City (15.2%) (Table 1).

Employment

The labour force in Windaroo-Bannockburn in 2001 represented 68.5% of people aged 15 years and over (down from 70.7% in 1991), higher than for Gold Coast City (57.6%). From 1991 to 2001, part-time employment in Windaroo-Bannockburn increased from 15.5% to 21.9% (Table 3). The unemployment rate* decreased from 7.5% to 6.5%.

Educational qualifications

In 2001, the proportion of people aged 15 years and over in Windaroo-Bannockburn with a Bachelor degree or higher was 7.8% (up from 5.7% in 1991), lower than Gold Coast City (Table 2)

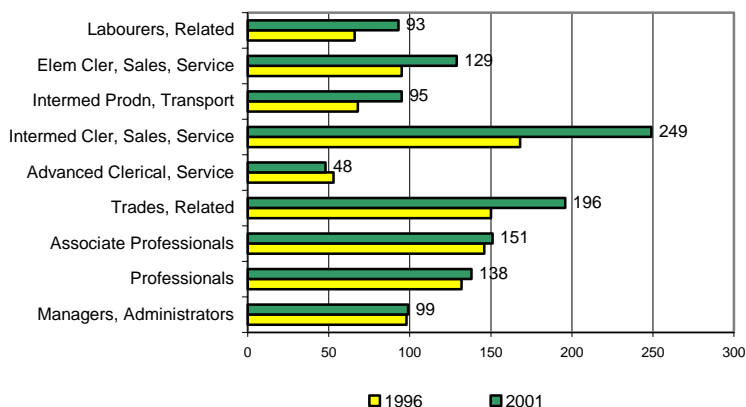

Income

The median gross weekly individual income in Windaroo-Bannockburn in 2001 was in the range \$400-\$499 (up from the \$120-\$159 range in 1991). In Windaroo-Bannockburn, 17.5% of people aged 15 years and over received less than \$120 in 2001 (11.3% for Gold Coast City) and 10.8% received a high income of \$1,000 or more (7.3% for Gold Coast City) (Table 4).

Occupation

The main occupation in 2001 was Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service Workers (249 people or 20.3% of employed people) followed by Tradespersons and Related Workers (196 people or 16.0%) (Figure 1). Since 1996, the biggest increase was recorded in the number of people working as Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service Workers and the biggest decrease was in Advanced Clerical and Service Workers.

Windaroo-Bannockburn Statistical Profile

Place of birth

In 2001, 24.7% of the Windaroo-Bannockburn population were overseas born, 17.6% in main English speaking countries and 7.1% in other countries. The proportion of overseas born people in Windaroo-Bannockburn was higher than for Gold Coast City (24.4%) (Table 5).

Household types

In 2001, 66.2% of the population of Windaroo-Bannockburn lived in a family comprising a couple with children (compared to 44.9% for Gold Coast City), and 18.8% lived in couple only households. The proportion of people in one parent families increased from 2.2% in 1991 to 9.4% in 2001, while the proportion of people living alone increased from 1.3% to 2.7% (Table 6).

Tenure of dwellings

Of the 819 occupied private dwellings in Windaroo-Bannockburn, 33.3% were fully owned (down from 36.0% in 1991), 41.1% were being purchased and 23.0% were being rented. Windaroo-Bannockburn recorded lower proportions of dwellings being rented and higher proportions being purchased than Gold Coast City (Table 7).

Dwellings

In Windaroo-Bannockburn in 2001, 98.6% of all private dwellings were separate houses (down from 100.0% in 1991), 0.7% were semi-detached, row/terrace or townhouses (up from 0.0%), and 0.3% were flats, units or apartments (up from 0.0%). In Gold Coast City, 57.1% of dwellings were separate houses, 16.1% were semi-detached and 23.6% were flats (Table 8). The average household size in Windaroo-Bannockburn declined from 3.3 people per occupied private dwelling in 1991 to 3.2 in 2001.

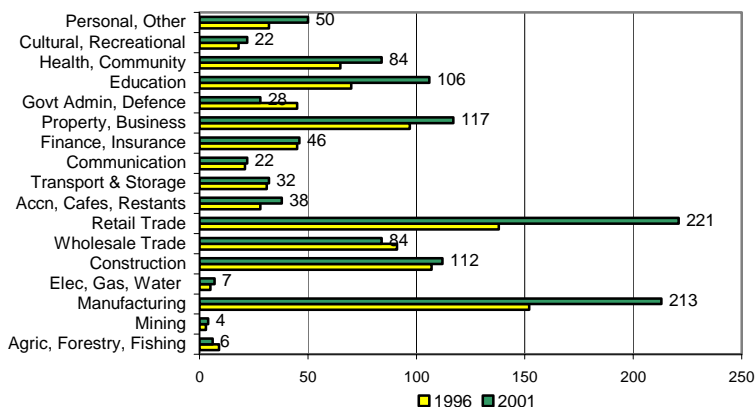

Industry

The main industry of employment in 2001 was Retail Trade (221 people or 18.0% of employed people) followed by Manufacturing (213 people or 17.3%) (Figure 2). Since 1996, the biggest increase was recorded in the number of people working in Retail Trade and the biggest decrease was in Government Administration and Defence.
