So we usually start at 4 in the morning. Drive down here from the Southport depot and always do Surfers beach every morning first thing.

We work our way from Kurrawa, go north up the Spit. Each day we work where we finish, we start the following morning.

Look your out in the open on the beach. Pretty passionate about doing a good job and keeping the beach clean for the tourists and the locals.

A lot of tourists love to come down in the mornings to capture that sunrise, They are always down here half an hour before hand. It's a pretty good office.

You always find things from bathers, to wallets, to phones. All sorts of things.

About 30 years ago it came from a potato harvester and the council got wind of it and they bought the idea over and they got the boiler makers and the welders together and put it all together for the beach.

A lot of people like to pull me up and ask me how it works.

You have to be very careful; safety is a big issue so you have to make sure, to expect the unexpected too with some people and young kids. Sometimes they see the tractor and might want to run to their parents in front of the tractor so you have to be pretty aware.

I've got a lot of locals I see most mornings, give them a wave, a lot of the lifeguards. It's good. I love it, I love it. I'm pretty passionate about keeping the beach clean and it's a good job and a good lifestyle.
