Palm Beach Parklands – providing space for people and dogs

The existing Palm Beach dog off leash exercise area has been extended along Currumbin estuary.

So that the parklands stay clean and safe for everyone there are a few golden rules to keep in mind when visiting with your dog.

- Read and follow the signs – they will guide you to where your dog is allowed.

- When you take your dog to the beach, follow the path with the blue paw prints and keep it on the leash.
- The children’s playground is for people only – it is off-limits to dogs, as are all playgrounds across the city.
- Because of hygiene reasons, dogs are not allowed in the grassed picnic and events area.
