



Beree Badalla- Tarrabora Reserve

Tarrabora Reserve and Beree Badalla

This is a beautiful 2.4km return walk along the Currumbin Creek Estuary. Starting at Palm Beach Parklands, the track winds it's through Tarrabora Reserve through lowland coastal forest that is cared for by the Tarrabora Bushcare group. From there, the track continues to the southwest along the boardwalk through Beree Badalla Reserve. The boardwalk features stunning views through the mangroves and out over Currumbin Creek. The boardwalk finishes at Thrower Drive boatramp, or you can continue the walk into Salk Oval Parklands where there is further car parking and a small sandy beach.

Level of fitness: Suitable for all fitness levels. Easy tracks.

Facilities: Toilets, drinking water, picnic tables.

Access: Via Thrower Drive (near Thrower Bridge), or Gold Coast Highway (at Palm Beach Parklands on the corner of Thrower Drive)
