Boundary Street (adjacent village shops)	2 hours max, 9am–5pm, daily

McLean Street – change to existing time limits	2 hours max, 9am–5pm, daily
Dutton Street – change to existing time limits	2 hours max, 9am–5pm, daily
Chalk Street carpark (northern end)	3 hours max, 9am–5pm, Monday to Friday
Marine Parade (Queen Elizabeth carpark)	4 hours max, 9am–5pm, daily

*no changes will be made to existing special use bays such as disabled parking, loading zones etc.

Pacific Parade (western side adjacent local shops)	2 hours max, 9am–5pm, daily
