Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* that on 15 September 2017, the Council of the City of Gold Coast resolved to repeal the *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017*, effective 2 February 2018. The purpose and general effect of the resolution is to confirm the expiry of the *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 3 (Party houses) 2017* and align with the commencement of a replacement Temporary Local Planning Instrument.

Notice is given under the *Planning Act 2016* that on 15 September 2017, the Council of the City of Gold Coast adopted the *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 4 (Party houses) 2018* for the City of Gold Coast.

The *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 4 (Party houses) 2018* will take effect on 2 February 2018 and cease to have effect on 2 February 2020, unless repealed sooner. The *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 4 (Party houses) 2018* has retrospective effect.

The purpose and general effect of the *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 4 (Party houses) 2018* is to enable the regulation of party house land uses by:

- identifying all of the planning scheme area as a party house restriction area; and
- affecting the operation of the planning scheme by making material change of use for a party house impact assessable and applying assessment provisions for development applications for material change of use for a party house.

The *Temporary Local Planning Instrument No. 4 (Party houses) 2018* overrides specified provisions of the Gold Coast City Plan.
