

Part 8 Overlays

8.1 Preliminary

- (1) Overlays identify areas within the City Plan that reflect state and local level interests and that have one or more of the following characteristics:
 - (a) there is a particular sensitivity to the effects of development;
 - (b) there is a constraint on land use or development outcomes;
 - (c) there is the presence of valuable resources;
 - (d) there are particular opportunities for development.
- (2) Overlays are mapped and included in **Schedule 2**.
- (3) The changed category of development or assessment, if applicable, for development affected by an overlay are in **Part 5**.
- (4) Some overlays are included for information purposes only. These will not result in a change to the category of development or assessment or any additional assessment benchmarks.
- (5) Required outcomes for accepted development subject to requirements and assessment benchmarks for assessable development for an overlay may be contained in one or more of the following:
 - (a) a map for an overlay; or
 - (b) a code for an overlay; or
 - (c) a zone code; or
 - (d) a development code.
- (6) Where development is proposed on premises partly affected by an overlay, the required outcomes and assessment benchmarks for the overlay only relate to the part of the premises affected by the overlay.
