(Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No.5) 2021

Title

1. This notice may be cited as *Council of the City of Gold Coast (Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 5) 2021*.

Making of local law

2. Council of the City of Gold Coast (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 3 December 2021, made *Subordinate Local Law No. 7.5 (Public dive precincts) 2021* (the "Subordinate Local Law").

Commencement

3. The local law commenced on 24 December 2021.

Purpose and general effect

4. The purpose and general effect of the amendments to the local law is to—
 - Allow the City to regulate access to the precinct and ensure the protection of human safety and of the natural and built environment.
 - Allow the regulation of admission and mooring access and business undertakings.
 - Provides grounds as to how and when the precinct can be closed.
 - Define activities that are prohibited (such as fishing, general boating and recreation, anchoring and damaging structures).

Anti-competitive provision

5. The subordinate local law contains anti-competitive provisions.

Inspection
