

Bruce Bishop carpark

General conditions of use

By entering this carpark you accept these conditions of use. The Council of the City of Gold Coast reserves the right to refuse entry to any vehicle or person.

1. The carpark is a 'regulated carpark' and fines can be incurred for breaching traffic regulations.
2. All vehicles entering this carpark must be registered. Abandoned vehicles or vehicles left for extended periods of time without approval will be towed away from the carpark. All expenses incurred due to towing or to retrieve the impounded vehicle are payable by the vehicle owner.
3. No trailers are to be brought into the carpark without the prior approval of management.
4. No alcohol is to be consumed within the carpark and no skateboard riding is permitted.
5. Each pass is valid for one entry and one exit per car at any one time. Passes cannot be shared throughout the day.
6. Passes can be cancelled without notice and at any time should they be misused or if conditions of the carpark are breached.
7. The maximum charge for the day(s) a vehicle has been parked will be made if no parking permit pass is presented.
8. The Council of the City of Gold Coast may restrain the departure of a vehicle if the person who enters or drives the same vehicle does not have a parking pass or pay the parking fee.
9. The Council of the City of Gold Coast may move or drive a vehicle within or from the carpark if it appears necessary or convenient to do so due to a safety risk, obstruction or nuisance.
10. The Council of the City of Gold Coast shall not be liable, nor shall any employee, servant or agent of the Council be liable for:
 - the safe custody of any vehicle
 - the loss of (including but not limited to removal by an unauthorised person) or any damage to a vehicle or any accessories attached or contained therein
 - the death or injury of any person in or about the carpark however such death or injury is caused or occurs.
11. The rights and conditions set by the Council of the City of Gold Coast may be exercised by any employee, servant or agent of the Council.
12. The Council of the City of Gold Coast will exercise all due care and skill in its services within the carpark and these 'conditions of use of carpark' are not to be construed in any way excluding or limiting that warranty.
13. Lower levels of carpark are under the 1:100 year flood parameters. Do not use lower levels during floods.
14. In these conditions:
 - The 'carpark' means Bruce Bishop Carpark
 - 'The Council' means Council of the City of Gold Coast
15. The carpark pass shall not be used for hire or rental vehicles that are being returned or left for hire or rental.
