## **(Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 2) 2017**

### **Title**

1. This notice may be cited as *Council of the City of Gold Coast (Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 2) 2017*.

### **Commencement**

2. This notice commences on 11 August 2017 (Gazette Notice Date).

### **Making of local law**

3. Council of the City of Gold Coast (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 25 July 2017, made *Local Law No. 21 (Major City Events) 2017* (the "local law").

### **Purpose and general effect**

4. The purpose and general effect of the local law is to provide for—
  - (a) the designation of events as a major city event which will occur in a specified area during a specified period and be subject to laws which will facilitate the conduct of the major city event;
  - (b) the carrying out of works for a major city event;
  - (c) the regulation of access to, and the conduct of persons attending, a major city event;
  - (d) the regulation of the use of vehicles and bicycles at a place where a major city event takes place;
  - (e) the regulation of the undertaking of commercial activities associated with a major city event;
  - (f) the regulation of the grant, cancellation and suspension of permits associated with the undertaking of a major city event;
  - (g) the review of decisions made under a local law which relate directly or indirectly to the undertaking of a major city event; and
  - (h) the exercise of enforcement powers under the local laws of Council associated with the undertaking of a major city event.

### **Anti-competitive provision**

5. The local law contains anti-competitive provisions.

### **Local law amended**

6. The local law amends existing local laws of Council as follows—
    - (a) *Gold Coast City Council Local Law No. 2 (Regulated Parking) 2006*;
    - (b) *Local Law No. 7 (Council Property) 2008*;
    - (c) *Local Law No. 9 (Parks and Reserves) 2008*;
    - (d) *Local Law No. 10 (Bathing Reserves) 2004*;
    - (e) *Local Law No. 11 (Roads and Malls) 2008*;
    - (f) *Local Law No. 16 (Licensing) 2008*; and
    - (g) *Local Law No. 44 (Heavy Vehicle Parking) 2007*.

## **Consolidated versions of local laws**

7. Council has prepared and adopted a consolidated version of each local law referred to in paragraph 6 by resolution dated 25 July 2017 and the consolidated versions are available for inspection and purchase.

## **Inspection**

8. Copies of the local laws referred to in each of paragraphs 3 and 6 may be—
  - (a) inspected and purchased at Council's public office at Bundall customer service centre, 8 Karp Court, Bundall, and at any of our other centres and are available on Council's website; and
  - (b) viewed by the public on the website of the Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning.
