Coombabah Lakelands Conservation Area trails

This flat reserve is home to an abundance of native wildlife including kangaroos and koalas. Dogs are not permitted. It's a great spot for bushwalking, mountain biking and nature study. The gates to the reserve are unlocked and open from 6am-6pm daily. Toilets are not available. For the Mangrove boardwalk enter via Shelter Road. All other tracks are accessed from Rain Tree Glen or Myola Court.
