City of Gold Coast aquatic centres are committed to providing positive, healthy, and memorable experiences.

We have adopted a partnership approach with allied health professionals, providing a variety of access options to our centres.

Whether it's treatment for clients in the warm water program pool, lap swimming pools, or fitness centres, there are options to suit your needs.

Previously the City has charged a casual rate of \$13.10 which includes access to our centres for both the professional and client.

Under this partnership, your client's access to our centres will be a separate charge to that of the professional.

The benefit of this approach is that your clients have convenient access to the centres whenever they choose, and professionals have a variety of access options based on the frequency of centre use.



How this works for the client

To access the centre, the client purchases admission from one of the following options:

- Casual entry (one visit)
- 10 or 25 visit passes
- Three-month membership

How this works for the allied health professional

To access the centre, the professional purchases either a multi-visit pass or a corporate membership which provides flexibility, value and convenience based on the frequency the centre is used.

The proposed charges for this service are outlined below:
