What can I recycle?



- paper and cardboard
- aluminium and steel cans
- plastic bottles and containers
- glass bottles and jars (brown, clear and green only)

REDUCE. REUSE. RECYCLE.

Place recyclables loosely in the bin, not in plastic bags.

AUSTRALASIAN RECYCLING LABELS

Most packaged products in Australia display the Australasian Recycling Label (ARL) to help you put items in the right bin.

Look for the ARL label on your packaging when throwing it out to remove confusion and divert recyclables away from landfill.

What can I place in my green organics bin?

This bin has a lime green lid and is used for garden organics only. Your green organics bin will be emptied each fortnight, on the alternative week to your recycling bin.

Please do not use any bags or bin liners but place your green organics loosely into the bin. Do not use for food scraps.

What can I put in my general waste bin?

These bins are for general household waste like plastic bags, broken cups and plates, mirrors and nappies.

New and repaired general waste bins will have a red lid in line with national codes for waste.

Everything you put in this bin will go to landfill.

Unsure how to dispose of something? Visit cityofgoldcoast.com.au/recycling

- batteries
- building materials, bricks, tiles or large timber off-cuts
- electrical appliances
- tree stumps
- motor parts or car batteries
- liquids, paints, oils or solvents
- sand gravel or concrete
- used syringes, needles or sharps that are not inside a sealed leak proof container

The City's waste management facilities experience peak demand between 10am and 2pm. Avoid delays by timing your visit outside these hours.
